Bartsch 94; Hinterding/Rutgers (New Hollstein 312 II (of IV); Nowell-Usticke 94 I (of VI, before the extension of the curved lines in the archway to the capital and before filling in the gaps in the upper left). - A splendid, concise early impression with rich contrast.

Three sides with fine margin around the plate mark, the lower margin approx. 0.9 cm.
