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Item Description: One (1) of two (2) bluish green oval modified brilliants set in a pair of closed back white metal earrings with numerous near colorless round brilliants.

Weight: 2.20 grams (gross)

Measurements: 7.33 x 5.16 mm

Comments: This copper and manganese bearing tourmaline may be called "paraíba tourmaline" in the trade. The name "paraíba" comes from the Brazilian locality where this gem was first mined, however today it may come from several localities.

The depth of the stone is not measurable due to the mounting.

Only one (1) bluish green stone was tested at random.
