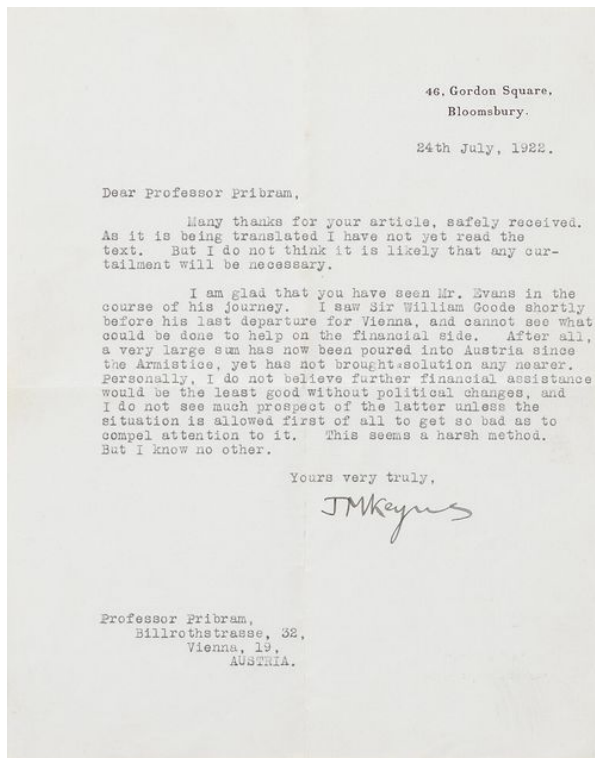

Dear Professor Pribram,

Many thanks for your article, safely received.
As it is being translated I have not yet read the
text. But I do not think it is likely that any cur-
tailment will be necessary.

I am glad that you have seen Mr. Evans in the
course of his journey. I saw Sir William Goode shortly
before his last departure for Vienna, and cannot see what
could be done to help on the financial side. After all,
a very large sum has now been poured into Austria since
the Armistice, yet has not brought solution any nearer.
Personally, I do not believe further financial assistance
would be the least good without political changes, and
I do not see much prospect of the latter unless the
situation is allowed first of all to get so bad as to
compel attention to it. This seems a harsh method.
But I know no other.
