Comments: This copper and manganese bearing tourmaline may be called "paraíba tourmaline" in the trade. The name "paraíba" comes from the Brazilian locality where this gem was first mined, however today it may come from several localities.
This color of tourmaline is commonly heated to improve or change the color. Whether or not this gemstone has been heated cannot currently be determined.
