



FRAGMENT OF A TAPESTRY BORDER

Renaissance, Bruxelles, probably from the workshop of François Geubels, ca. 1560.

Allegorical representations of Generosity and Justice under a canopy, with three eagles on top. In an architectural frame.

167 x 66 cm.

Colors faded. Restorations. The fragment on offer was part of the border of a large tapestry; very similar borders are found, for example, in the tapestries from a series about Romulus and Remus by François Geubels, which are on exhibit i.a. in the Kunsthistorische Museum in Vienna (Guy Delmarcel. *La tapisserie flamande*. Paris 1999, pp. 155ff.). In that tapestry, the group of figures is somewhat
