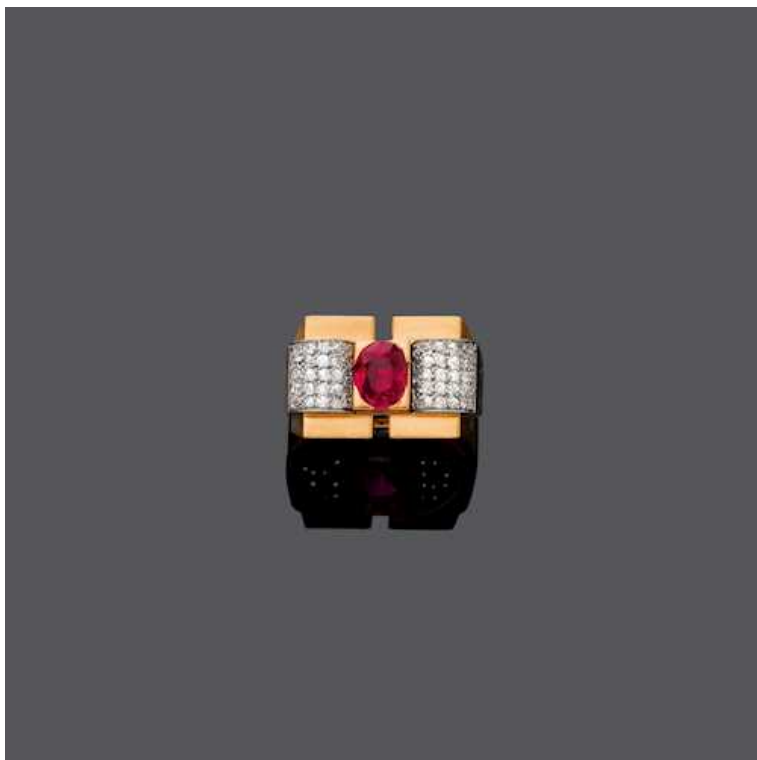

Geographical origin: **Myanmar (metamorphic)[†].**
The physical and chemical characteristics of the observed ruby are similar to those found in rubies from Myanmar (formerly Burma).

Treatment: **No indications of thermal treatment (NTE)[†].**

Conclusion: The examined gemstones are of natural origin.
