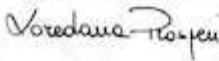
The white gold ring, stamped "9 904 AL" and "750", weighing 6.40 grams, sets:

- No. 01 transparent, purplish red NATURAL RUBY (variety of corundum) with oval shape and composite cut.
Estimated Weight: 1.00 ct
Comments: no indications of treatments (NT).
Geographical Origin: Myanmar (Burma).
- No. 14 transparent, colorless NATURAL DIAMONDS with navette shape and modified brilliant cut.
