The September auction series garnered international interest and two world records

World auction record

The most important works in the 23 September Old Master Paintings auction elicited determined international bidding, realising strong prices, including two world auction records. 'The Offering to Ceres', a striking large-format *Caravaggisti* painting by Dirck van Baburen, was the subject of a bidding war which saw its price rise from its estimate of CHF 500 000/800 000 to sell to a private international collector at CHF 1.4 million, a record price for the artist (lot 3029). Another record was set for the delicate depiction of the Allegory of Patience by Giovanni Maria Butteri. Painted after a model by Antonio Vasari, the work attracted numerous telephone and online bidders, including a private European collector who won the work with a final bid of CHF 171 000 (lot 3008, est. CHF 20 000/30 000). A painting by Denijs van Alsloot and workshop depicting a grand feast organised for the Archduke Albrecht VII of Austria and Isabella Clara Eugenia of Spain tripled its estimate to sell for CHF 464 000 (lot 3050, est. CHF 150 000/250 000).


A roundel by Adriaen Pietersz. van de Venne (lot 3020, est. CHF 300 000/400 000) fetched CHF 378 000, and an Allegory of Autumn by Jacopo Bassano tripled its low estimate to sell for CHF 244 000 (lot 3023, est. CHF 80 000/120 000). Both works by Angelica Kauffmann found new buyers, a self-portrait for CHF 67 000 (lot 3071, est. CHF 30 000/50 000), and an mythological scene, 'Dido at the stake', for CHF 85 000 (lot 3074, est. CHF 70 000/90 000).

Among the 19th Century Paintings, all three works by Eugène Boudin sold for above the high estimates, including a classic scene of the port of Le Havre with tall sailing ships that fetched CHF 177 000 (lot 3208, est. CHF 120 000/160 000). A watercolour by John Frederick Lewis in the Old Master Drawings auction fetched more than twice its low estimate at CHF 110 000 (lot 3472, est. CHF 40 000/60 000).

The Books & Autographs auction on 21 September featured the *magnum opus* by artist and naturalist Maria Sybilla Merian on the insects and fauna of Surinam which changed hands for CHF 146 000 (lot 207, est. CHF 120 000/160 000), and the rare and classic work by Francesco Colonna, 'Hypnerotomachia Poliphili', that realised CHF 183 000 (lot 217, est. CHF 50 000/80 000).

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
