Ergebnis: CHF 948 000

A rediscovered folding triptych by Lucas Cranach and Studio was the top lot in Koller's 31 March Old Master Paintings auction in Zurich. Dating from circa 1515, it shows a tender depiction of the Annunciation on its central panel, flanked by panels with Saints Barbara and Catherine. One of the last surviving German Renaissance altarpieces available for purchase, it sold to a European collection for CHF 948 000 (lot 3014, est. CHF 800 000 / 1 200 000).

An 'Allegory of the five senses' by Flemish artist **Jan Cossiers**, circa 1640 sold for **CHF 439 000** (lot 3045, est. CHF 400 000 / 600 000), and an important still life from the Dutch Golden Age by **Willem Claesz. Heda** changed hands for **CHF 488 000** (lot 3027, est. CHF 400 000 / 600 000). A sleeper in the Old Master auction was a small genre scene by Haarlem artist **Hendrick Heerschop**, which pulverised the previous auction records for this contemporary of Vermeer at **CHF 189 000** (lot 3044, est. CHF 5 000 / 7 000). A charming Madonna and Child by Florentine renaissance artist **Jacopo del Sellaio and Studio** quadrupled its estimate at **CHF 165 000** (lot 3003, est. CHF 40 000 / 60 000). Among the 19th Century Paintings, a beautifully painted interior genre scene by the Hungarian 'Prince of painters', **Mihály von Munkácsy**, also sold for four times its estimate at **CHF 403 000** (lot 3231, est. CHF 100 000 / 150 000)
